Cross-border-linked terrorist attacks in India-2014 to present

December 5, 2014: Mohra

Terrorists attack an army camp at Mohra in Uri area of Baramulla district; 10 Army men and six terrorists are killed.

March 20, 2015: Jammu police station

Two terrorists in army uniform storm a police station on the Jammu-Pathankot highway in Kathua and kill three security personnel and two civilians, before they are gunned down by the State police and security forces. It was the first major terrorist attack after the BJP-PDP formed the government in Jammu and Kashmir.

July 27, 2015: Gurdaspur

Three civilians and four policemen are killed when gunmen fire indiscriminately in Punjab's Dinanagar town in Gurdaspur district.

January 2, 2016: Pathankot Indian Air Force base

In what is seen as one of the biggest security breaches in the country, a group of terrorists launch a pre-dawn attack on the airbase. Three security personnel and the five terrorists are killed in the gunbattle.

June 25, 2016: Pampore

A two-member fidayeen squad of the Lashkar-e-Taiba attacks a CRPF convoy on the Srinagar-Jammu national highway near Pampore town in south Kashmir. Eight personnel are killed and 20 others are severely injured.

September 18, 2016: Url

In a deadly strike on an Army camp near the headquarters of 12th Brigade at Uri in Baramulla district, terrorists kill 19 soldiers and injure 30.

October 3, 2016: Baramulla

Militants attack the 46 Rashtriya Rifles camp outside Baramulla. One jawan is killed.

November 29, 2016: Nagrota

Armed militants storm the Indian Army's artillery unit at Nagrota in Jammu district, killing two officers and five jawans. Three militants are killed in the gun battle.

March 7, 2017: Bhopal-Ujjain train bombing

Suspected Islamic State militants set off an explosive device in a passenger train in Madhya Pradesh. Ten people are injured.

July 10, 2017: Amarnath Yatra

Terrorists attack a bus carrying pilgrims returning from the Amarnath shrine in Anantnag district. Eight pilgrims are killed.

February 10, 2018: Sunjuwan

Eleven soldiers are killed in a terrorist attack on the Sunjuwan Army camp in Jammu.

February 14, 2019: Pulwama

More than 40 CRPF soldiers are killed as a Jaish-e-Mohammed militant rams an explosives-laden vehicle into a convoy of buses carrying CRPF personnel on the Jammu-Srinagar highway at Awantipora in south Kashmir.
